For the first time in my life I finally know what I believe and am secure in that belief. There is more to this than I can state in a short testimony but I would recommend anyone read the Torah or in Scripture the first five books carefully and let the Set Apart Spirit lead you into the truth. I have included the referenced scriptures at the end for easy access but I beg of you do not take my word for this, read it for yourself.

I believe that Yeshua is the Messiah and for us to be included in His family we must follow Him in the Torah. Not manmade law or tradition but His commands as He ordained them. John 1 says He is the Word, therefore if He is the Word then we should be doing the Word / Torah. Yeshua said follow me which means do as I do. John 3:36 We must not believe only, but also obey, this is our proof that we are His.

He was the author of the Sabbath and His appointed times according to Lev. 23.

Our blessings come from following Him in the Sabbath as written in Is 58:13-14 He kept the Sabbath and the appointed times and he says He does not change. Also, Heb 7:21 says He is a priest forever after the order of Malkitsedeq and as priest will he not keep the appointed times? He is the truth and does not change, 1Sa 15:29, Mal 3:6, Jas 1:17.

I live by Lev. 23 and find my life centered on His Sabbaths and appointed times. I also follow the Torah dietary laws, Lev 11.

Yeshua was the Passover lamb that was sacrificed. When He said 'It is finished' he did not mean done away with, but completed Mt. 5:17-20. He made the sacrifice for the sin of death by His death, read Num 35:25-28.

As a believer and a follower I am a part of His family. I cannot prove to be related by blood but I can come in as a sojourner who chooses to do as He does. See Ex. 12:49 and Eze 47:22. Also Isa. 56:8 & John 10:16 say there are other sheep to be gathered in to the fold. These are the sojourners who choose to obey His Torah, who guard His Sabbath and commands.

Many believe that the apostle Paul was sent to the gentiles Act 9:15. Yes he was sent to the nations Rom 11:13-36, but his message was to the lost sheep of the house of Israel, and any Gentiles entering the faith of Israel to provoke to jealousy those of his people.

Paul was a Pharisee of Pharisees. He obeyed and taught from a Hebrew Torah. To understand his teachings one must think like he did and know the difference between Torah law and manmade traditional law. Laws in the Torah apply to different people according to the situation. There are priestly laws, commands for cleanliness both for men, women, and lepers. Then there are dietary laws. Paul knew and understood all of these as did all the disciples and this is what all of them taught followers of the Way. Mat 28:19-20

Rom 3:31 Do we then nullify the Torah through the belief? Let it not be! On the contrary, we establish the Torah.

I believe we as believers in Messiah Yeshua 'MUST' follow Him in His written Torah. If we believe in Him how can we do any less? Let us come along beside Brother Judah and learn the truth, provoking him to jealousy so that he will rise up and seek Yeshua too. As an example I will tell you of an encounter I had with Brother Judah. In conversation with a man he asked if I was Jewish and told me he was. I explained who I was and he then asked if we kept the Sabbath and the dietary laws. When I said yes he was crestfallen and said 'I miss that, I have not practiced my faith in a long time'. What a blessing that was for me to be used by Elohim to provoke him to jealousy.

Rom 10:17 so then belief comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of Elohim. He is 'the Word of Elohim'. Again I refer you to John 1.

Mic 6:8 He has declared to you, O man, what is good. And what does YHVH require of you but to do right, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your Elohim?

I implore you, do not take my word alone, search it out, pray and seek the truth. I know my Elohim will guide anyone who truly seeks Him in truth.
